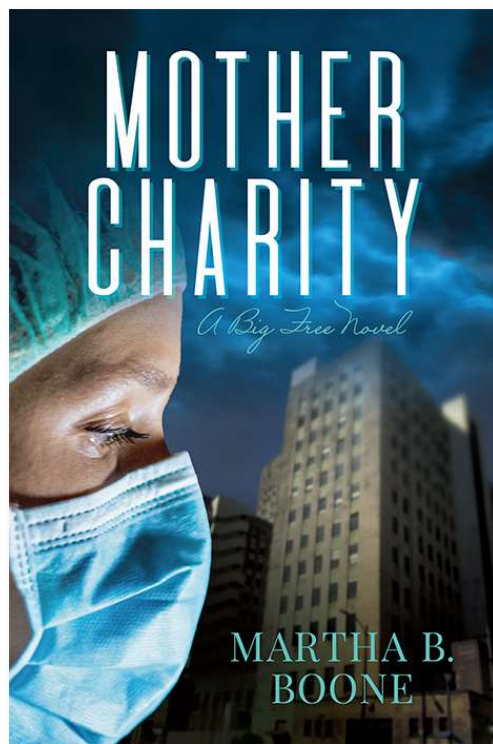
Evolving from a naive girl to a competent female surgeon, Elizabeth has survived the first round of surgery training.
